Acer campestre (Field Maple)	Native, picturesque, medium sized tree, frequently used in rustic hedges	£1.95
Alnus glutinosa (Alder)	Small-medium size bushy tree, yellow catkins in March	£1.47
Betula pendula (Silver Birch)	Slender white bark, delicate leaves and drooping branches a graceful medium sized tree.	£2.18
Carpinus betulus (Hornbeam)	Dense upright habit, spring catkins, thick easily managed hedge, 18" apart	£1.88
Cornus 'Flaviramea' (Yellow Dogwood)	Makes a dense thicket hedge with yellow stems and autumn fruits	£2.40
Cornus Sibirica (Siberian Dogwood)	Makes a dense thicket hedge with dark red stems and autumn fruits	£2.85
Corylus avellana (Hazel)	Yellow catkins late winter early spring, good for attracting wildlife	£1.80
Crataegus monogyna (Hawthorn)	Forms a dense armoured hedge, white blossom, red berries, plant 9" apart	£1.45
Fagus 'Atropurpurea' (Copper Beech)	Large tree, light red leaves turning purple, makes excellent hedge	£3.60
Fagus sylvatica (Beech)	Native, wavy margined leaves, dense habit, prunes & trims easily	£1.88
Ilex aquifolium (Holly) P9 pot	Evergreen, glossy leaves, flowers in summer, long lasting berries in autumn	£3.60
Ligustrum 'Aurea' (Golden Privet)	Lovely shrub, dense upright habit, makes excellent hedge, easily managed	£4.05
Ligustrum ovalifolium (Privet)	Makes reliable dense evergreen hedge, trims & shapes easily, plant 18" apart	£2.80
Malus sylvestris (Crab Apple)	Pretty pink flushed white flowers in late spring followed by green-yellow fruits	£1.80
Prunus avium (Wild Cherry)	Attractive native tree with pretty white flowers in spring followed by red berries	£2.18
Prunus padus (Bird Cherry)	Strong growing native tree, pendulous white blossom in spring	£2.18
Prunus spinosa (Blackthorn)	Attractive with white blossom, black sloe berries. 1ft apart for dense hedge	£1.30
Quercus petraea (Sessile Oak)	Native, large long-lived tree, long-stalked leaves, produces acorns	£2.70
Quercus robur (Common oak)	Native, large long-lived tree, produces acorns	£2.18
Rosa canina (Dog Rose)	Thorny dense thicket, good barrier hedge, spring blossom, red autumn hips	£2.28
Rosa rugosa 'Alba' (White Ramanas Rose)	Fragrant dense shrub rose single white flowers, orange-red hips height 1-2.5m	£2.10
Rosa rugosa (Ramanas Rose)	Fragrant dense shrub rose, single flowers then orange-red hips height 1-2.5m	£2.10
Salix alba (White Willow)	Makes excellent wind break, forms a thick growing barrier height 30ft	£1.80
Salix caprea (Goat Willow)	Native, yellow or silver catkins in spring	£1.80
Sambucus nigra (Elder)	Upright bushy shrub with white flowers early summer followed by black fruit	£1.47
Sorbus aucuparia (Mountain Ash)	Native, small-medium size, bright red fruits in autumn, easily grown	£2.10
Taxus baccata (English Yew)	Dense evergreen, good hedge and topiary	£5.25
Viburnum opulus (Guelder Rose)	Native, small white flowers spring-summer followed by bright red fruit	£2.18
